2011 has been a year of astonishing news. It began with the boys and girls soccer teams earning MIL league titles. The boys earned third place honors in the state tournament. The intermediate Science Olympiad team placed third in the Maui and state competition. The 34 member Class of 2011 garnered over \$2.6 million dollars in scholarships to attend college. The Girls Air Rifle Team placed first in the MIL league and the boys team placed third, earning individual honors at the state level. Senior, Matthew Matasci’s essay on sustainably earned him a seat at the APEC conference held on Oahu in November. The band program will present it’s spring concert at the MACC on April 17, 2012. A special invitation has been extended to band director, Mr. Everett Yamashita and his students to perform at Carnegie Hall in April of 2013. The Japanese class took first place in the Mikoshi (portable shrine) Design Contest, opening up an opportunity for 20 students and their chaperones to participate in the annual Honolulu Festival parade in March. 8th graders Micah Leval and Amelia Imada earned first place honors for their “Smoke Free” posters sponsored by the Great American Smoke Out.
