A few "things to know" items for you:

- Parents of children attending our Summer Camp Program and our Catapult Learning Program will receive guidelines for drop-off, monitoring and pick-up procedures tomorrow, 6/25. Both programs start 6/29.
- SAS is excited for school to start on August 4th! Parents will receive the general school calendar for the 2020-2021 year on Wednesday, July 1st.
- We have been reviewing all school safety guidelines and will be prepared as school re-opens. Parents will receive guidelines specific to our campus by 7/17/2020.
- We are working on providing additional extended day options for our K-5 students to support families and their work/child care needs.
- We are working on starting an extended day program of structured intramurals and study times for students in Grades 6 - 12 to support student interests and to support families' work schedules too.
- We are aligning our MS and HS bell schedules to increase opportunities for students in grades 6-8 to access up campus classroom spaces including robotics, additional science labs, and a new Student Success Center.
- The Student Success Center will be located on the HS campus and will allow students to take online classes - during the school day - that will cover some basic classes, advanced classes, dual-credit classes (high school and college credits earned) and other elective classes not offered anywhere on island.
