

### **SAS School Day Start and End Times:**

Grade School classes start at 8:00 a.m. and end at 2:30 p.m.

Middle School and High School classes start at 8:05 a.m. and end at 2:35 p.m.

Weekly Friday Schedule includes early dismissal for ALL grades at 1:30 p.m.

### **SAS Extended Day Program:**

Extended Day Program for K-5th Grade starts at 2:35 p.m. and ends at 5:00 p.m. each day. Extended Day Program calendar will reflect days it is not available.

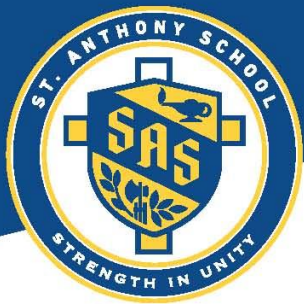
Parents must pre-register via email to [sgomes@sasmaui.org](mailto:sgomes@sasmaui.org). Weekly pre-payment to be done via the Main Office. We need to ensure we have a reserved spot for your child and we must monitor the number of students attending each day. The amount per week is \$40. We will use two rooms in order to provide more social distancing and to provide a separate room for students needing to do homework after school.

### **Grade School and Middle School/High School Handbooks:**

We need to update our Parent/Student Handbooks so please refer to weekly eblast updates and updated website information for changes to school day times, drop off procedures, etc. These are fluid times and are requiring updates more than ever before.

For example, this is a new guideline that will be in our updated handbooks:

All students and staff are required to bring and wear a personal face mask to school each day. All parents, guardians and visitors are expected to do the same. Face masks for students do not have to be school-issued or purchased through the uniform company. Face masks are expected to be appropriate in design, wording and images though. Parents/guardians will be contacted if there are any issues with this and we appreciate support from home prior to students entering campus each day.



## School Drop Off and Pick Up Guidelines:

Please refer to last week's drop off guidelines for K-12 students. We are thermo scanning ALL students prior to entry to their classrooms each day so we expect that it will take a few days to streamline the process. Everyone's patience and cooperation with this is appreciated as we all want to be consistent and safe with the start of the school day.

Pick Up guidelines for the start of the year are listed below:

ALL students, staff and parents/guardians are required to wear face masks while on campus; including daily dismissal times.

Students in **Grades 4 - 12** will be dismissed by their teachers and then go to their parent's/guardian's vehicle to head home. Students in Grades 4 and 5 that are signed up for the Extended Day Program will go directly to those designated rooms at dismissal. Unless a student in Grade 4 -12 is part of a school-sponsored club or activity they must exit campus by 3:00 p.m. each day.

Students in **Grades K - 3** will be dismissed from their classrooms and parents/guardians are required to wait for them on the GS playground inside the fence along Lower Main Street. The access gates to the GS playground on Lower Main Street and near the GS Library will be unlocked by 2:15 p.m. each day to allow parents to enter campus and align in the designated areas. It is vital that ALL who are picking up their children go to the designated spots as we must ensure that nobody goes directly to the classrooms. Your cooperation is appreciated as we want our students to safely connect with their parents before heading home each day.

Students in Grades K - 3 that are signed up for the Extended Day Program will wait outside their classrooms and follow directions by staff to line up to go to the designated rooms.
